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Bronze Camp - Role Descriptions

Bronze Camp Manager

The Bronze Camp Manager is ultimately responsible for the organisation/running of the camp/course.

Responsibilities include:

- Organising course timetable
- Organising course equipment
- Organising course Food
- Overseeing course coordinators & leaders
- Communication with parents*
- Liaising with Chief/Vice Chief Instructor

Training Coordinator (Must hold TOC)

The Training Coordinator is responsible for overseeing all course training (dry/wet) throughout the course.

Responsibilities include:

- Preparing training equipment for sessions
- Allocating trainers to sessions
- Creating interactive sessions for trainers to deliver
- Overseeing course delivery from TAF's
- Giving feedback to Trainers
- Liaising with Camp Coordinator & Water Safety Coordinator

Water Safety Coordinator

The Water Safety Coordinator is responsible for overseeing all water activities/training/water safety personnel during the course.

Responsibilities include:

- Preparing Rescue Equipment for water activities
- Delegating water safety roles to trainers/leaders
- Overseeing water safety for any water-based activity
- Liaising with Bronze Camp Manager and Training Coordinator

Kitchen Coordinator

The Kitchen Coordinator is responsible for buying/preparing meals throughout the day. (All Leaders will be on Kitchen Duty to assist the coordinator)

Responsibilities Include:

- Liaise with Bronze Camp Manager
- Purchase groceries/supplies
- Prepare Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner meals (on rotation)
- · Assist with other camp duties as required







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Social Media Coordinator

Responsible for gathering and capturing footage throughout the camp. All team members welcome to bring the following (GoPro, Drone or Camera with accessories!)

- Gathering all footage from devises
- Posting updates on club Facebook/Instagram stories
- Creating Tiktok stories
- Monitoring Bronze Camp FB Group for questions

Trainer (Must hold TOC)

The trainer will deliver course sessions as outlined by the Training Coordinator. To be a trainer, you MUST have a current (TOC).

Responsibilities include:

- Preparing a session plan
- Delivering the session plan
- Assist in course assessments and admin
- Liaising with Training Coordinator and Water Safety Coordinator

Group Leader

A Group Leader will be responsible for their selected candidate group for the duration of the camp.

Responsibilities Include:

- Assist candidates in day-to-day activities
- Assist trainers with delivering session plans
- Assist camp coordinator with any other tasks as required

Water Safety

Water Safety are responsible for maintaining adequate water safety/supervision while training in the water.

Responsibilities Include:

- Preparing water safety equipment
- Preparing training equipment
- Liaising with Water Safety Coordinator
- · Assisting with any other tasks as required

**Members who are successful in a camp position MUST undergo a 1-2 day training (as outlined in the EOI form)
